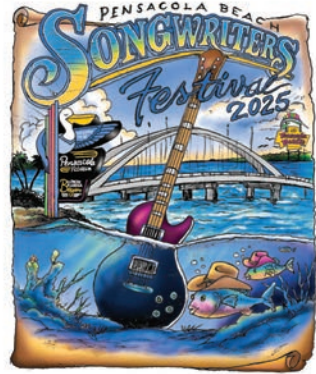

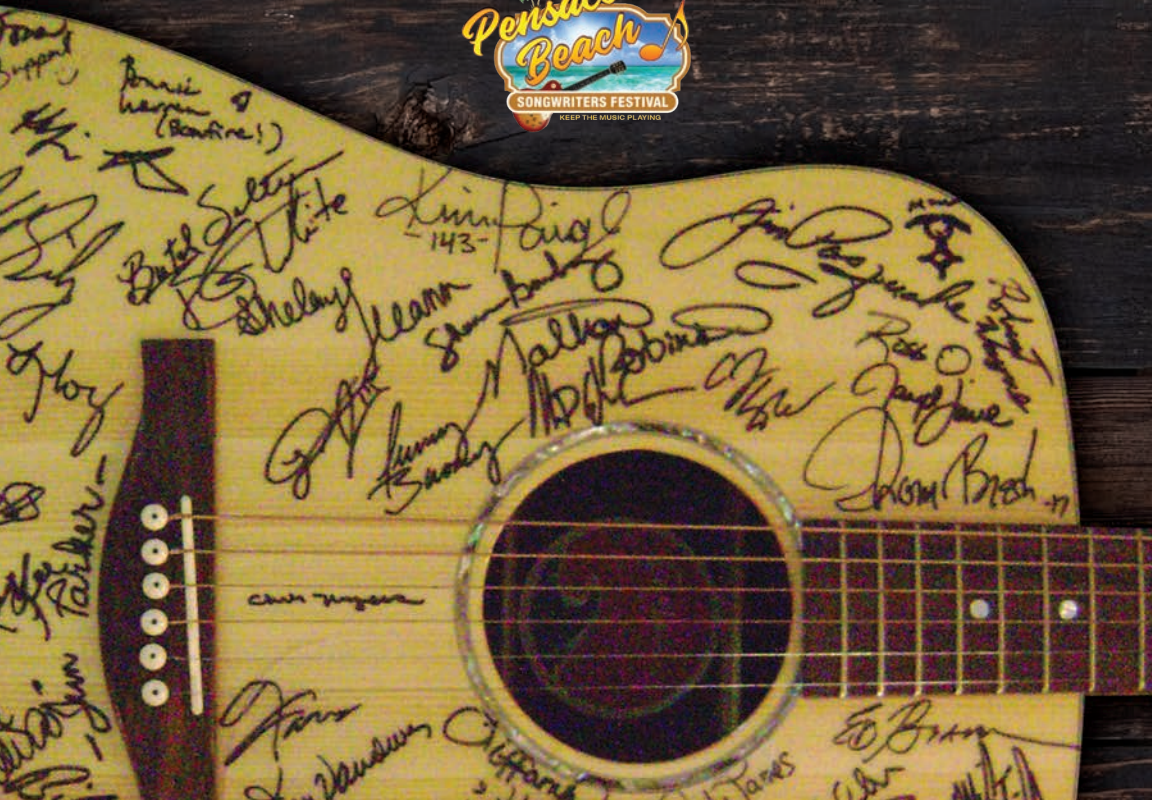

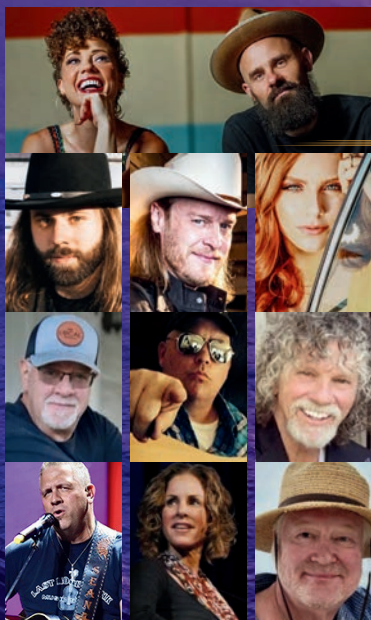

### **JESSEY ADAMS**

Multi-award-winning singer/songwriter Jesse Adams showcases a powerful combination sound of outlaw and traditional style country music. Embodying the spirit of a vagabond, her music has taken her across the United States to perform wherever there are neon lights and dusty floorboards. Jesse was the Grand Prize Winner of PBSF Song competition 2024 and the Michigan State Fair Superstars competition (2024) and is a nominee for five Josie Music Awards.



### **JAMES ADKINS**

James Adkins, based in Ohio, creates music rooted in Americana, blending folk, bluegrass, and roots traditions with his unique voice. With two decades of experience, his heartfelt storytelling and intricate musicianship resonates with fans of John Prine, Gillian Welch, and Jason Isbell. A seasoned performer, he has played at various venues and festivals across the Eastern U.S. and is currently expanding his touring to include more shows in the Southeast.



### **ALLISON ALDRICH**

Allison is an award-winning Christian Singer/songwriter from Ocala, FL. Her goal with her music is to provide a ray of hope to someone in a world of darkness. What began as a simple goal of building an organic fan base to promote her music soon inevitably transformed into a beautiful and unique ministry in live streaming on TikTok. Thousands of lives have been impacted by Allison through TikTok alone.



### **DYLAN ALTMAN**

Throughout his career, Dylan has written three No.1 songs -Tim McGraw's "Watch The Wind Blow By," Jake Owen's "Barefoot Blue Jean Night," and Jason Aldean's "Take A Little Ride." His songs have also been recorded by a wide range of artists, including Eric Paslay, Chase Bryant, Joe Nichols, Eli Young Band, Gloriana, Jennette McCurdy, Trace Adkins, Will Hoge, Gabe Dixon, John King, JT Hodges, Ted Russell Kamp, Hayden Panettiere, and more. His versatility as a songwriter has allowed him to collaborate with both established and up-and-coming artists, making him a sought-after talent in Nashville.



### **GARY BAKER**

Gary earned a Grammy for the smash hit "I Swear," which he co-wrote with Frank J. Myers. It crossed over to the number one spot on the pop charts. He also co-wrote "I'm Already There," which hit number one on the country charts before crossing over to the top five on the pop charts. His first number one was "Once Upon a Lifetime," by "Alabama". Through the years, he has penned hit songs for numerous other artists including the Backstreet Boys, 98 Degrees, and Reba McEntire. His songs have been featured in numerous high-profile television show and movie soundtracks.





### **NICK BEIBICHER**

Nick is the former owner of SandyRoots records which dissolved in 2024. Nick is still pursuing his career as a professional songwriter and recently had a song cut "Chaser" by a new WME signed artist Colby Swift that climbed the Texas syndicated radio charts to the top 20. Nick also recently had another cut by Sasha Lee and the song is currently on the Texas syndicated radio charts. He is also continuing to be a recording engineer, producer and live audio engineer. Nick is the in house audio engineer for all the ticketed events at Docies Dock in Ft Walton beach and is forming a new company called "Right Vibe", which will offer event management, entertainment and Live Audio services.



### **BENNETT HALL - BAND**

Three sisters. One voice. A legacy that lives on. Meet Kat, Presley, and Josie Hope. The band formed in 2017 and is named in tribute to their brother, Bennett, who passed away in 2010. This trio blends raw talent, heartfelt storytelling, and sisterly harmony into a sound that's as unforgettable as their story. The trio has played Tennessee and beyond on stages such as Grand Ole Opry, The Station Inn, CMA Fest, El Dorado Festival, Tom Petty Weekend, Dierks Bentley's Whiskey Room, and more. They're currently opening for Jamey Johnson on select tour dates.



### **TYRON BENOIT**

Tyron is known for his energetic, hard-driving music that blends Louisiana's dance-floor accordion, electric guitars and powerful rhythm section. A true singer/songwriter, Tyron also shares heartfelt ballads about life, love, and loss, drawing from his experiences as a combat veteran and devoted family man. His dynamic stage presence shifts between a fiery preacher and soulful troubadour, creating a familiar and inviting atmosphere for fans. In 2024, he and his band showcased their talent at 15 major festivals, while also opening for prominent artists like Samantha Fish.



### **DANA HUNT BLACK**

Dana Hunt Black has had #1 songs recorded by George Strait like "Check Yes or No" and "Write This Down" (both won Song of the Year) and nine album cuts including "I Know What I Want For Christmas" which she co-wrote with her husband, Charlie Black, Nashville Hall of Fame songwriter. Other songs recorded: Gary Allan "It Would Be You", as well as songs by Suzy Boggus, Alan Jackson, Clay Walker and various other artists.



### **BLUE ANCHOR BELLES**

The Blue Anchor Belles are a singing trio of military spouses from all over the US that are currently stationed in the Pensacola area. They travel the emerald coast bringing 40's/ 50's favorites to veterans and their families in unique vintage three part harmonies.



### **AUSTIN BOHANNON**

Austin Bohannon is an award-winning country music artist from Russellville, Alabama. His passion for music ignited while he was pursuing his dream of becoming a Division I baseball player, during which he began writing songs in his spare time. After graduating from UAB, Austin returned to his hometown, located just outside of Muscle Shoals, Alabama—the renowned “hit recording capital of the world”—to start recording his music. With over 2 million streams, Austin has firmly established his presence in the country music scene. He has shared the stage with Trace Adkins, Shenandoah, and LoCash, and his infectious energy consistently captivates audiences, winning over every room he enters.



### **SHAWN BOWLING**

Shawn Bowling’s songwriting and musical style is heavily influenced by bluegrass & gospel from his childhood in the Ozark’s and by traditional blues from his years in the Mississippi Delta. A well-spring of inspiring stories is drawn from his work in ministry, medicine, and the military, as well as his always entertaining family and friends. Love and devotion to God, his family, and friends provide meaning to everything he does. Shawn grew up in a family of musicians and has been active in music all his life.



### **RONNIE BOWMAN**

Ronnie Bowman is a household name in the Bluegrass community. He has been awarded IBMA Male Vocalist of the Year three times, has twice earned the IBMA song of the Year award, and Gospel Performance of the Year. Both Brooks & Dunn, and Kenny Chesney have brought Ronnie Bowman originals to #1, and Lee Ann Womack also included a song by Ronnie on the multiplatinum selling album “I Hope You Dance”. He has seen continued songwriting success with three songs on Chris Stapleton’s multiplatinum selling album “Traveller”. The single “Nobody To Blame” won Ronnie the ACM “Song of the Year”. The album received the ACM and CMA “Album of the Year” award as well as a Grammy for “Country Album of the Year”.



### **WOODY BRADSHAW**

Woody is a Pensacola native who resides in Nashville, a recording artist and actor, best known for his chart-busting song and video, “The Last Thing You Do.” Before finding fame as a musician, Woody was an actor in New York City on an ABC daytime drama and in Los Angeles he was in numerous national commercials, television spots, and more. Woody knew his musical artistry was longing for expression, and he moved to Nashville to nurture his writing and singing career. Woody has felt the calling of his beloved hometown and has penned and released two songs: “It’s Good to Be Home (Pensacola),” and his new, rocking anthem in honor of Pensacola’s very own Blue Angels titled “The Blues Are Back In Town.”



### **DONNA BROOKS**

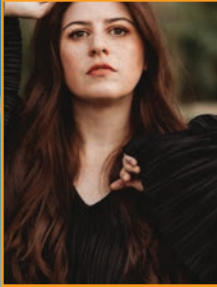
Donna Brooks grew up in Florence, Alabama, unaware of the musical scene in nearby Muscle Shoals, where legends like Aretha Franklin and Bob Dylan thrived. Despite this, she absorbed the diverse musical influences of the area, blending country, folk, rock, R&B, and blues into her own style. Known for her versatility, Donna’s songwriting reflects this eclecticism. Her latest EP, “It’s Just Rain,” features songs that address her recent cancer diagnosis and recovery. The title track is our PBSF 2025 Rock Song Competition Winner.





### **JIM "MOOSE" BROWN**

Jim "Moose" Brown won the Grammy award for Best Country Song for co-writing "It's Five O'clock Somewhere", Alan Jackson, Jimmy Buffett and the Coral Reefers) and he has had songs recorded by Martina McBride, Willie Nelson, Steve Wariner, Jamey Johnson, Mo Pitney, John Schneider, Heidi Newfield, Tyler Farr, Darryl Worley, Ronnie Milsap, Josh Turner, David Allen Coe, James Otto, Joe Nichols, Teea Goans, Eddie Montgomery, and others. He has toured and recorded extensively as a member of Bob Seger's Silver Bullet Band, is also a Grammy Nominated record producer and an in demand session player who has played on countless hit singles and albums.



### **ANNE BUCKLE**

Anne Buckle is a singer-songwriter and teaching artist originally from Peachtree City, GA. A graduate of Harvard University and the University of Tennessee, her first few years out of college were spent working for the U.S. Department of State in Washington, DC, at the U.S. Embassy in Paris, France, and in Tennessee higher education policy. In 2015, she made the decision to pursue a career in music full-time and has since shared the stage with the late Charlie Daniels, toured with Augustana opening for The Chicks, written songs recorded by other artists including American Idol's David Archuleta, and released her own original songs amassing over 4 million streams across platforms.



### **KEITH BURNS**

Keith Burns is a founding member of the Grammy-nominated ACM & AMA award-winning, platinum-selling group Trick Pony. He has had three Top 10 songs for Trick Pony and Joe Diffie and has also written several Top 40 songs with such artists as Hootie & The Blowfish, Sammy Kershaw, Burns & Poe, Mo Bandy. You've probably sung out loud to his signature hits "Pour Me" and "Just What I Do" for Trick Pony and many more!!



### **JASON BYRD**

They say Nashville is full of musicians who have spent years hoping to get in front of the right person. Someone who can change the trajectory of their whole career. For Jason, that person was legendary Country music artist George Jones, and he became Jason's manager and mentor. Jason began opening for powerhouse artists including Billy Dean, Joe Diffie, Tracy Lawrence, Confederate Railroad, Mark Chesnutt, Loretta Lynn, Dierks Bentley, and, of course, George Jones, who he recorded a duet with that earned a Josie nomination. Additionally, Jason has had several appearances on the world-famous Grand Ole Opry and The Nashville Network.



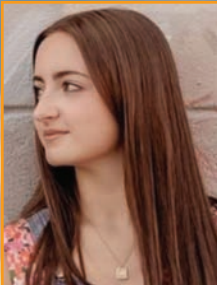
### **KRIS "MUDBONE" CALDWELL**

He gained recognition for his debut single "Family Man" and subsequent hits like "Fish" and "Keep Them Kisses Comin'". Seventeen year old Layla is our 2025 PBSF Song Competition Youth Category Winner. Born to a family steeped in musical tradition, Layla Capri has a heart to write real songs for real people. As an Indie Christian artist, she has made significant strides in her musical journey. With a story marked by faith, resilience, and passion, Layla's songs radiate hope and the unwavering love of God. Layla is on a mission to inspire and uplift through her gift of song.



### **FRANK CARSON**

Frank Carson is a country artist and songwriter from the Florida panhandle. At 23 years old, his deep resonant voice blends well with his emotional and energetic songs. Before moving to Nashville, he was a regular performer in his local Florida music scenes, having been a finalist in six singing competitions. One such competition was the 2023 Gator Idol competition judged by Season 16 American Idol winner Maddie Poppe. In that competition, Frank won the fan favorite award. Just before moving to Nashville, Frank opened for Chris Lane on his Find Another Bar tour in Gainesville, FL. Now, Frank writes and plays in the Nashville music scene, expanding upon the fanbase he built in Florida.

### **JASON JUSTICE**

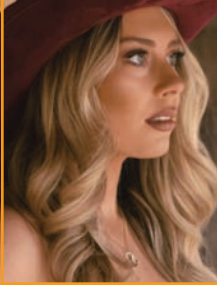

### HANK ADAM LOCKLIN

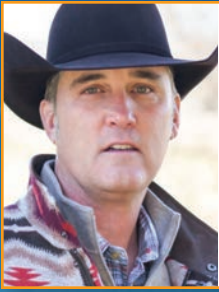

While she has penned most of her own songs, Jamie has also written hits for such notable artists as Reba McEntire, Martina McBride, Leann Rimes, Cece Winans, Idina Menzel and others.



### **ROSS ORENSTEIN**

Award-winning children's songwriter Ross Orenstein started his career writing music for McGruff the Crime Dog and later created the Safety Ape for a Radio Disney Tour promoting safety messages. He produced a literacy puppet show for Coca-Cola and a PBS children's show featuring Eco the Butterfly. His short film "Be a Green Hero" won best score at the Show Low Film Festival in 2022. He started playing drums at age 6 and guitar at 12, later signing with Curb Records in Nashville. Pitney has released two studio albums: "Behind This Guitar" (2016), which peaked at No. 10 on Billboard's Top Country Albums chart, and "Ain't Lookin' Back" (2020). His single "Country" reached the Top 40 on the Country Airplay chart. His debut album was produced by Tony Brown, while his second album was produced by his collaborator Jim "Moose" Brown.



### **JONATHAN PUZAN**

Jonathan was born and raised on the island of Guam. He then relocated to Southeast Missouri to pursue audio engineering, songwriting and art. He is currently living on the Gulf Coast, Puzan plays feel good easy listening music, "a little bluesy, a little rock, but unlike anything you've ever heard". 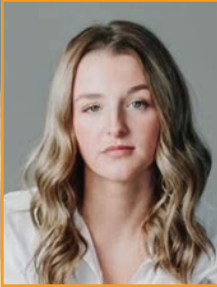
### **NATHAN ROBINSON**

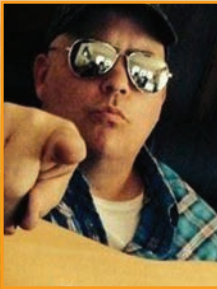
### **DERIC RUTTAN**

He traveled on the road for almost a decade and played for artists like Bob Carlisle, Michael English, Charlie Peacock, Mindy McCready, Trent Wilmon, Tim Rushlow (Little Texas singer), Derryl Perry, and many others. He currently writes for Shakes Spear Music. He's had cuts on Big Machine duo Maddie & Tae, 2012 American Idol winner Phillip Phillips, RCA RECORDS pop artist Betty Who, 3x Grammy Winner Keb Mo, Shenandoah, Ronnie Dunn, Bucky Covington, George Canyon, Canadian Duo Autumn Hill, Jo Hikk, Mama's Blue Dress, Mark Cooke, The Roys, and more.



### **BUTCH SALTER**

Butch Salter hails from Burnt Corn, Alabama. At around fifty years old, he purchased a guitar for \$50 and spent a couple of years trying to teach himself how to play. He consistently played for 22 years, learning a few songs and even writing a couple of his own, along with some poems. However, it wasn't until he met Jim Pasquale (PBSF Co-founder & Hit Songwriter) about 11 years ago that he truly honed his writing skills. One day, Jim called Butch and asked him to come over to collaborate on a song. After struggling to make progress, they began talking, and Butch shared a story about someone he knew. The conversation led to the line, "I don't care if he don't like me," to which Jim replied, "I don't care if he does," and the song came to life. Jim played a pivotal role in helping Butch find joy in writing and making music. He was not only a hunting partner but also one of Butch's best friends.



### **DON SAMPSON**

Don Sampson signed his first publishing deal in 1985 with New Clarion Music and later joined Sea Gayle Music in 2000 after various successful deals. Sampson is known for his songwriting, with notable #1 singles including Brad Paisley's "Waitin' On A Woman," Gary Allan's "Tough Little Boys," Alan Jackson's "Midnight in Montgomery," and Bryan White's "Rebecca Lynn." "Waitin' On A Woman" also earned the NSAI Song of the Year honor in 2009. His accolades include numerous ASCAP awards, seven NSAI awards, and the TNN Music City News Songwriters Award. Numerous artists have recorded his songs, including Darius Rucker, George Jones, Tammy Wynette, Willie Nelson, and Kenny Chesney. Don Sampson's contributions continue to resonate with fans and fellow musicians alike.





### **WES SHEFFIELD**

Wes Sheffield is a renowned recording and mixing engineer, songwriter, and musician at FAME Recording Studios in Muscle Shoals, Alabama. He is celebrated for blending vintage analog warmth with modern production techniques, playing a vital role in preserving the iconic Muscle Shoals sound. Sheffield engineered and mixed tracks for The War and Treaty and his contributions to their album *Plus One* include singles like "Carried Away" and "Called You By Your Name". He also engineered Kensie Coppin's 2025 single "Texas in Me," which reached #1 on the Texas Music Charts, showcasing his talent for capturing Texas country music infused with the Muscle Shoals vibe. Additionally, Sheffield contributed to *More Than a Whisper: Celebrating the Music of Nanci Griffith* as both recording and mixing engineer.



### **COLEY MCCABE SHEPHERD**

Coley is a platinum-selling songwriter who hails from West Virginia. She has performed numerous times on the Grand Ole Opry. While on RCA Records, her song "Grow Young With You" was featured in the Natalie Portman / Ashley Judd film, "Where The Heart Is." Her writing credits include the top 5 She Daisy hit "Lucky 4 U." She also starred in the feature film "Alabama Love Story." One of her songs was recorded by the legendary Loretta Lynn, and she currently tours with her husband as the duo THOM & COLEY, taking the audience on an emotional rollercoaster with their songs, storytelling, and onstage chemistry.



### **THOM SHEPHERD**

Thom Shepherd, the CMA of Texas Songwriter of the Year, is an Austin-based touring artist who spent many years in Nashville as a songwriter. He performs as a solo acoustic storyteller and in a duo with his wife, Coley McCabe. His hit "Always Saturday Night," was featured in "The Parrot Heads Documentary" with Jimmy Buffett. Thom has written five #1 singles for other artists, including "Redneck Yacht Club" (Craig Morgan), "Riding with Private Malone" (David Ball), and "Beer Season" (Kevin Fowler). In total, over 100 of his songs have been recorded by artists like Easton Corbin and Pam Tillis. After moving to Texas in 2011 for a full-time touring career, he emphasizes the excitement of live performance.



### **JEFF SILVEY**

Indiana native Jeff Silvey, a two-time ICA Producer of the Year for his work with Kali Rose, joined his first Gospel Quartet at age 14. As a talented pianist and baritone singer, he grew up in a music-rich environment, sharing a hometown with Bill and Gloria Gaither. Over the years, Jeff has made a significant impact in Christian and Country music, with over 300 songs recorded by artists like George Strait and Easton Corbin. His achievements include four RIAA-certified Gold and two Platinum albums in Christian music, plus four Gold and one Platinum single in Country music. He won the 1997 Dove Award for his Country Album of the Year, "Little Bit of Faith."



### **DONNA SLATER**

Donna Slater's vocal style is best described as pure americana and is the perfect complement to her songwriting. Donna's spirit shines strong through her originals as she ventures into reflections on navigating life's challenges and temptations. Her new album of originals "Let it Burn" is available on all digital platforms.



### **ANTHONY SMITH**

Anthony Smith is a critically acclaimed Singer/Songwriter, Music Row Songwriter of The Year, and winner of multiple NSAI, BMI, and ASCAP awards. He has written songs performed by superstars such as George Strait, Taylor Swift, Tim McGraw, Blake Shelton, Chris Stapleton, Trace Adkins, Faith Hill, Montgomery/Gentry, Rascal Flatts, Kenny Chesney & Coley McCabe, Randy Houser, Craig Morgan, Trisha Yearwood, Kenny Rogers, Lonestar, Confederate Railroad, Blackberry Smoke, Shooter Jennings, Sammy Kershaw, Don Williams, Ronnie Milsap, Lorrie Morgan, David Allen Coe, Tommy Shane Steiner, Kevin Denny, Halfway To Hazard and many more.

CJ Solar, influenced by Southern rock, country, and Delta blues from his Cajun childhood, expertly blends these genres. Recognized as one of the "New Artists You Need To Know" by Rolling Stone Country, he attributes his success to a deep passion for the music he grew up with rather than fame. While touring and opening for artists like Lynyrd Skynyrd and Hank Jr., he continues to write and record, having released three EPs and his debut album "The Future's Neon" in 2022. ### **KAREN STALEY**

Add to these accolades Tatum's own Album released on all platforms, her single releases, Gretchen Wilson single, (Summertime Town from "Ready to get Rowdy"), Randy Houser (Fired Up 2016), Kristy Lee Cook (Lookin' for a Cowgirl), The Farm (Farm Party), and George Clinton cuts, you have the makings of a woman building a sustainable music career for a lifetime of success.



### **PAYTON TAYLOR**

A soulful young woman, Payton lets her heart guide her songwriting and storytelling. Rooted in country and soul, she draws inspiration from female pioneers in these genres. Her musical journey began with her grandfather's record collection, which resonated with her old soul. At 15, she moved to Nashville with bandmates to pursue her dream, performing in honky tonks while honing her craft. He has also written for artists like Garth Brooks and Willie Nelson. In 2009, he won the Nashville Songwriters Association’s Songwriter of the Year Award and debuted at the Grand Ole Opry in 2011. Wynn continues to write daily, tour extensively, and is signed with BMG Music Publishing.



### **ROBERT WAYNE KALKUP**

Robert Wayne was born in Battle Creek, MI and raised in nearby East Leroy, MI. His love for singing was taught to him by his mother. She was an undiscovered super star with a voice that could stand in a room with Patsy Cline and Loretta Lynn. Matt Warren, a Nashville native, started his career as a staff writer in 2002 after signing with House of Fame in Muscle Shoals, AL. 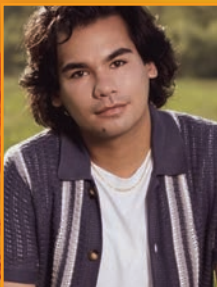
### **JUSTIN WILSON**
